GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. It is the responsibility of the contractor and/or sub-contractors to obtain all required permits necessary to perform the work described above and to properly post/display them clearly at the job site.
- 2. It is also the responsibility of the contractors and sub-contractors to ensure all required inspections are requested and passed, up to and including the final inspections from the City of Ocala Building Department and the Community Development Services Department.
- 3. Due to this being an owner-occupied residence, the contractor MUST coordinate with the Owner and City of Ocala Building Department/Inspectors when requesting the necessary inspections for this project. (Owner may move out during construction.)
- 4. All references to equivalent imply the substituted goods/materials must meet or exceed the specifications of the brand requested.

Item 1 - Kitchen cabinets

- 1. Remove and dispose of all existing backsplash and countertops.
- 2. Provide and install a range microwave similar in design and color to the existing one.
- 3. Provide and install Formica countertops with 4-inch backsplash, color will be selected by homeowner at contract signing.
- 4. Install a new 8" stainless steel double bowl sink with single lever Delta faucet with sprayer or reinstall the owner faucet, including all related plumbing, water supplies, and shut-off valves.
- 5. Repair paint, and drywall/backsplash as needed.
- 6. Please Delete the OTR microwave.
- 7. Add a 30" range similar in style and color to the existing one

Item 2 - Plumbing

- 1. Install a new insulation blanket on the water heater.
- 2. Install the water heater discharge pipe to code.
- 3. Reinstall and secure water heater covers.
- 4. Install timer for water heater, Intermatic WH40 Water Heater Timer equal or better.
- 5. Replace the pressurized well tank, equal in size or bigger.
- 6. Remove and reset the hall toilet level to the floor.
- 7. Add In the master bath, and replace the shower, door, and shower valve with a similar to the existing one.
- 8. Add in the hall bath, replace the tub, wall surround, and shower valve with similar to the existing one.
- 9. Repair the window so that it does not hold water and is leak-resistant.

Item 3 - Electrical

- 1. Replace GFCI receptacle at pool pump.
- 2. Check electrical wiring at well and make any repairs to code.

Item 4 – Interior

- 1. Remove floor coverings throughout except for the hall bath.
- 2. Repair all cracks, holes, and soft areas in existing flooring. Install high-density 7/16" or equal padding. Allowance of 320 sf of plywood, 100 lf of 2x8 lumber.

- 3. Prep the floor so that it is clean, dry, and level.
- 4. Replace carpet with new (max price \$2/s.f.), include transitions where needed.
- 5. Provide and install if needed shoe molding around the full perimeter of the flooring.
- 6. Kitchen/laundry/bathrooms use ceramic tile of similar style, size, and type. (max price \$2/s.f.).
- 7. Add plywood allowance to 480s.f ³/₄" T/G plywood and Prep floor so that it is as clean, dry, and level as possible.
